- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in Mathematics from 26% in Year 2 (2018) to 50% in Year 3 (2019)

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English from 38% in Year 2 (2018) to 75% in Year 3 (2019)
50% in Year 4 (2018) to 75% in Year 5 (2019)

Our initiatives include


- Commence the intensive BOOST extension program for students identified through school data (PM Benchmarks, Probe testing, teacher observations and student reports) as capable of attaining the upper two bands of reading, writing and numeracy.
- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for internal planning
- Provide targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: mathematics and english learning areas and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of essential mathematical and english concepts and skills in every classroom
- Continue to support staff to review, interrogate and analyse data, and to develop appropriate responses to data trends and participate in data conversations focused on monitoring student progress. Target - 100% complete diagnostic and summative data requirements (as per the school's Assessment and Reporting Plan and Whole School Curriculum Plans).
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning
