Prep

- Connect number names, numerals and order numbers from 1 to 10. Partition and combine collections up to 10. Represent practical situations involving quantifying, adding to and taking away from collections to at least 10

- Describe position and location
- Collect, sort and compare data

Year 1

- Connect number names and numerals and order numbers to 120. Partition one- and two-digit numbers. Solve problems involving addition and subtraction to 20
- Give and follow directions
- collect, display and discuss data

Year 2

- Represent and order numbers to 999. Partition, rearrange and re-name two- and three-digit numbers. Solve additive problems.
- Identify and represent halves and quarters
- Locating features and creating and describing pathways on maps
- Collect, record, represent and interpret data

English -

Examining the features of poetry

Prep

- To View and comprehend a poem. Demonstrating understanding and making connections. To share thoughts and preferences when responding to poetry.

Year 1

- To view and comprehend a poem by making connections and comparing its text structures and language features with those of an information text. To share ideas and express opinions when responding to poetry.

Year 2

- To view and comprehend a poem and describe how similar topics are presented and organised in different types of texts. To express an opinion and appreciation of a text when responding to poetry.
