Task

Instructions

Write the first chapter of a fantasy novel.

Plan the first chapter of a fantasy novel

Create a 'good' and an 'evil' character for a fantasy novel.

Create a fantasy setting.

Use text structures and language features suitable for audience and purpose.

Draft the first chapter of a fantasy novel

Draft the first chapter:

Use text structures such as complex sentences and narrative point of view to provide structure and build meaning.

Use language features such as figurative language (similes, metaphors and personification), nouns and noun groups, and precise vocabulary to provide vivid descriptions of characters, settings and events.

Edit the first chapter of a fantasy novel

Ensure students have edited their draft for cohesive structure and meaning, correct grammar, spelling and punctuation.

Drafting in lesson time with access to teacher feedback and conferencing

Length: 300 words

HPE Having a ball

In this unit junior students will perform the refined fundamental movement skills of throwing (overarm shoulder pass and chest pass) and catching and use them to solve movement challenges. They will apply strategies for working cooperatively and apply rules fairly.

Explore how science knowledge helps people to understand the effect of weather on ecosystems

Investigate how knowledge about weather can influence practices in fields such as industry, agriculture and resource management.
